Question of the Week: "How can I use Montessori principles at home?"



Using Montessori principles at home is a great way to recognize and develop your child's ability to learn about the world around them; as well as encouraging their natural curiosity and passion for learning.

To incorporate Montessori principles, look at your home through the eyes of your child....

- 1. Are there opportunities for your child to help with meals?clean?garden?get their own snacks/lunch?
- 2. Emphasize life skills that are age appropriate. For example, younger children could help with watering plants, putting dishes in the dishwasher. Older children can help with meal preparation, basic home maintenance, and grocery shopping.
- 3. Teach concentration- away from digital sources
- 4. Focus on inner motivation, not rewards
- 5. Allow children to pursue their own interests



A NOTE FROM OUR GREEN PARENTS GROUP






