Did you know there are approximately 5000 Montessori programs in the United States, with only 570 of those being public?

The first public Montessori schools opened in the 1970s as part of the desegregation movement. Some early public Montessori schools were part of the Head Start program. The charter school movement in the 1990's saw an increase in Montessori in the public school sector. An estimated 300 new public Montessori programs have opened since 2000. Most public Montessori schools go through elementary school, Montessori high schools are quite rare, with about 150 high school programs in the United States.




